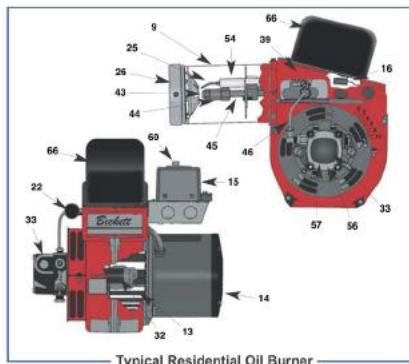

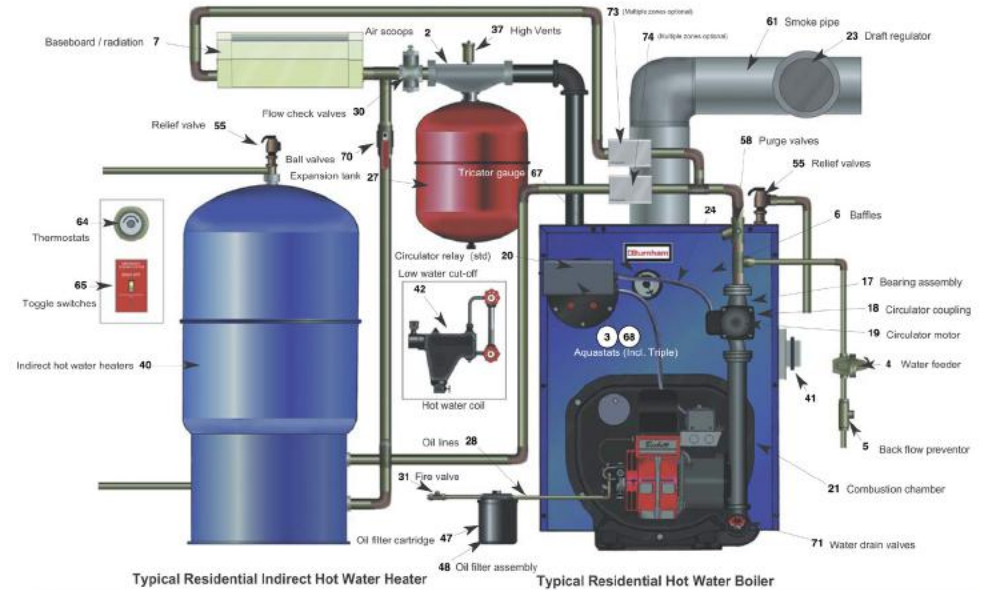
Typical Residential Oil Burner

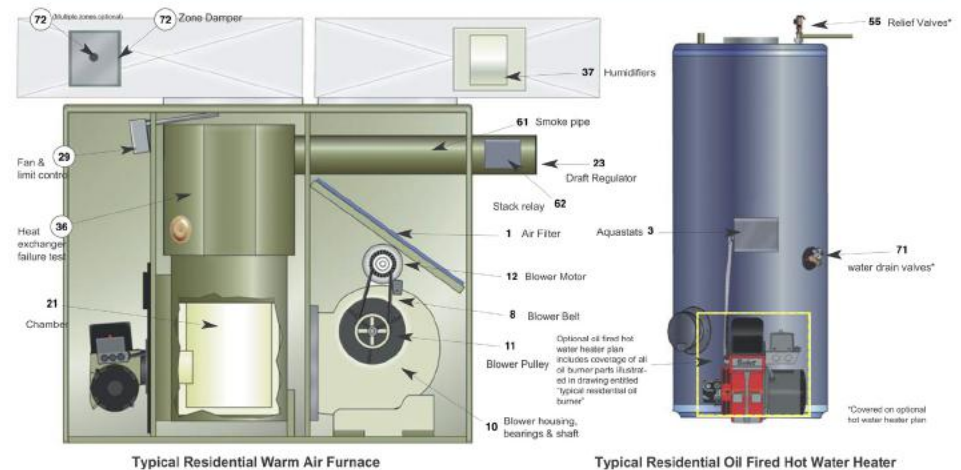
